

## **Summary of the July 21, 2020 Board of Trustees Meeting**

The Board of Trustees of the Alabama School of Cyber Technology and Engineering met today by Zoom/telephone conference, with members of the public allowed to listen in, under the authority granted by Governor Ivey in Section III of her emergency Proclamation of March 18, 2020. The Board of Trustees heard from ASCTE President Matthew A. Massey about Coronavirus funding provided by the State of Alabama and the new School Entry Plan, with school starting the third week of August. Patrick Sullivan and PeggyLee Wright of the Foundation, a 501(c)(6) entity, next gave the Foundation's third new building update. Mr. Sullivan stated that groundbreaking is planned for September 23, 2020 with substantial completion expected in May 2022. The Board next approved the financial report, which was given by Brandon Shoupe, the Board of Trustees Treasurer.

The Chairman, Senator Arthur Orr, announced the next meeting of the Board of Trustees will be September 23, 2020.
